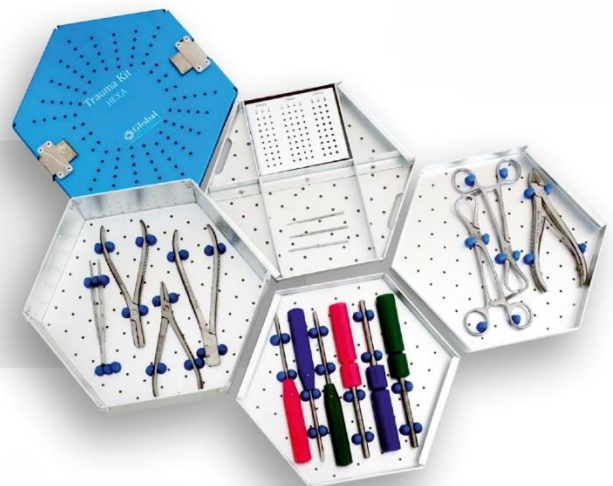


Hexa- Impaction kit @ ₹ 16,500
